If you are enrolled at one of our partner universities, you are eligible to apply for an exchange period at FDUL.

## Students from outside the EU/Schengen Area:

Must obtain a temporary study visa from the Portuguese Consulate or Embassy prior to arrival.

## Students from the EU, Switzerland, Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein:

- Do not require a visa;
- If staying longer than 90 days, must register at the local City Hall (Câmara Municipal) of their residence.

**EU/EEA students** should obtain the **European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)**, which provides access to public healthcare services in Portugal. The card is free and issued by your national social security services.

- Non-EU students must have valid international health insurance for the entire stay.
- Brazilian students may apply for the PB4 form, issued by Brazil's INSS.

All students at the University of Lisbon have access to the University Medical Center.
